



TRACK-101 PROGRAM

Riders with limited Track riding & racing experience.
USAC Cat. 4,5 (Track), USAC Cat 3,4,5 (Road) or No USAC License.

Licensing requirements for Garden State Velodrome.

ALL riders regardless of their cycling abilities and experience,
are required to be licensed to ride at the Garden State Velodrome. No exceptions.

If you have limited or no track riding & racing experience, And have a USAC Category 4, 5(Track),
Category 3,4,5(Road) or No USAC License, the licensing process is as follows:

- Register & sign up for a TRACK101 Clinic;
- Apply for a racing License at www.USACycling.org
- Read; TRACK CYCLING– An Introduction By Dan Currell; available at www.gsvelodrome.com
- A Completed New Rider Information Sheet; available at www.gsvelodrome.com
- Original signed copy of the GSVA and USAC Waiver; available at www.gsvelodrome.com
- Copy of your USAC License, if applicable;
- Copy of your Photo identification (driver's license);
- Copy of your recent Track riding / racing experiences, with a list of Velodromes you frequented, and with any contacts that know your skills and abilities.
- Clinic Fee: \$17. (Cash or Check made payable to *Garden State Velodrome Assoc.*)
or PayPay (online payment Only via www.gsvelodrome.com)
(Clinic which includes same night's open track training– not including Race fees, if applicable)

Otherwise, bring all copies of these documents with you to the TRACK 101-clinic.

For your first visit, please allow extra time to process you're your paperwork. During our first month of operation, there will be a lot of new and experienced riders to process. Our goal is to get everyone riding as quickly and safety as possible. We will do our best to get everyone licensed as soon as possible. ***There is a Limited number of riders per Clinic and we recommend you sign up early Online, as Onsite registration may be full.*** Once you have completed checking in you may proceed directly to the track for riding after daily registration and sign-in.

Clinic: A 1.5-2 hours Venue orientation in 2 Parts, covers basis track events & riding, rules, track etiquette and safe techniques of riding on the Velodrome. A Limited number of loaner Track bikes maybe available for these clinics. We are a unique venue as we still share the facility with motorsports. After showing competency and demonstrating proper Knowledge, Skills and abilities to ride at GSV. Upon completion and with approval, the rider may ride the track, yielding to other clinics on the track and while staying above the stayers line or directed by GSVA Staff. **GSVA staff reserves the right to require a rider to attend additional clinics before being licensed, if determined necessary to gain more experience before riding the velodrome individually.**

Bike setup: We recommend 700x23 Clinchers, GSV is a fairly smooth asphalt surface, Banking is approx. 25 degrees. Road sew-ups may also be used. We do not recommend "Track" edition Lightweight sew-ups or tires. *USAC Category 4 & 5 riders maybe required to use a restricted gear of 87" or less*

All bikes must be inspected for track compliance prior to riding. Staff reserves the right to make approval to ride the track for each rider on a case by case basis.
