



MADISON ENDORSEMENT

Riders with current GSVA Class A, B, C;
Class D* with prior approval from a GSVA Operations Manager

Licensing requirements for Garden State Velodrome.

ALL riders regardless of their cycling abilities and experience,
are required to be licensed to ride at the Garden State Velodrome. No exceptions.

In order to compete in Madison events at GSVA, Riders must be a GSVA Class A,B,C rider and have completed the required Madison (MAD) clinic, and have a issued Madison endorsement (MAD), affixed to their GSVA License.

Requirements for endorsement include:

- A Current GSVA License Class A,B,C; (Class D* with prior approval from the GSVA Operations Manager)
- Original signed copy of the GSVA Waiver; available at www.gsvelodrome.com
- Copy of your Photo identification (driver's license);
- Endorsement Fee: \$20. (Cash or Check made payable to *Garden State Velodrome Assoc.*) or PayPay (online payment Only via www.gsvelodrome.com)
- Completion of required GSVA Madison Clinic while showing proper knowledge, skills and abilities to ride a Madison Style event.

Bring all copies of these documents with you to registration/sign in. We highly recommend you Pre-register to save time.

Please allow extra time to process your Endorsement. During our first months of operation, there will be a lot of new and experienced riders to process. Our goal is to get riders riding as quickly and safety as possible. We will do our best to get you endorsed as soon as possible. ***There is a Limited number of riders per Clinic and we recommend you sign up early as Onsite registration may be full.*** Once you have completed you may proceed directly to the track for riding after daily registration and sign-in.

Clinic: 1-1.5 hours ; Covers track event & riding, rules, track etiquette and safe techniques of riding a Madison or Other like style events. After completing the clinic, fulfilling the requirements and showing proper knowledge, skills and abilities to ride a Madison event, GSVA may grant a Madison Endorsement, This will allow you to participate in GSVA events that that require a Madison endorsement (MAD).

Bike setup: We recommend 700x23 Clinchers, GSV is a fairly smooth asphalt surface, Banking is approx. 30 degrees. Road sew-ups may also be used. We do not recommend "Track" edition Lightweight sew-ups.

All bikes must be inspected for track compliance prior to riding. Staff reserves the right to make licensing decisions for each rider on a case by case basis.
